6008 Class Rank

Student class rank shall be determined by using two systems: the Scholastic Class Ranking System (SCRS) and the Academic Class Ranking System (ACRS). The SCRS will be determined by the weighted grade point average. The ACRS will be determined using the following model: ACT score + unweighted GPA x 9 + (earned credits/semesters). The ACT score used in the ACRS ranking will be from an ACT testing date prior to the final semester preceding commencement. The SCRS and the ACRS separately place the points in a high-to-low numerical order.

Students must be enrolled in the district's high school the last two semesters to be eligible to be included in class ranking.
